Work will include assisting the engineering team with development, integration, and test of simulation devices for training F-16CM fighter pilots in tactical in system procedures and tactical employment. The individual will be responsible for providing worldwide subject matter expertise, assisting with development and execution of test procedures, and acting as a liaison with end user representatives to ensure requirements are satisfied. Position may involve international travel in support of site stand-up and academic instruction to active duty Air Force Units and/or contract Instructors.

Required Qualifications: Personnel responding should have a Pilot rating and a minimum 500 hours in F-16CM Block 50 aircraft. Applicants should have an understanding of US Air Force mission requirements, latest tactical employment techniques, and operations. Recency of flight experience in the last three years.
